

Leadership Jackson County 2022 Confidential Application

WHAT IS LEADERSHIP JACKSON COUNTY?

It is the 32nd annual leadership program of the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce and Ocean Springs Chamber of Commerce Main Street—Tourism Bureau, designed to identify, educate, and motivate existing and emerging leaders to become involved in the future of Jackson County, Mississippi. The program is a nine-month course focused on expanding community awareness and building leadership skills. The group is sought from all segments of government, industry, education, small business, healthcare, financial, professional, and geographic areas. Candidacy is open to all, regardless of age, creed, race, or philosophy who seek to contribute their particular skills, knowledge, and expertise to the betterment of Jackson County, Mississippi.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE PROGRAM?

LEADERSHIP JACKSON COUNTY consists of a variety of "Go-See-Hear-Do" activities highlighting local industries, healthcare, legislation, law and public safety, natural environment, education-workforce development, governmental affairs, economic development, small businesses, tourism, and human services.

WHAT ARE THE MEETING DATES AND WHERE?

LEADERSHIP JACKSON COUNTY begins in January. Full-day sessions extend from January to September 2022. Each session runs roughly from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. A schedule is forthcoming.

WHO CAN APPLY?

Anyone who lives or works in Jackson County, Mississippi, or whose company serves the Mississippi Gulf Coast Region, may apply.

Instructions: It is important that each section is fully completed.

Complete each section fully. Limit answers to the space available. Application must be signed by both the applicant and employer/sponsor and returned to the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce. Completed application must be submitted electronically to catherine@jcchamber.com by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, December 7, 2021.

A completed application includes:

- 1. Original application
- 2. A letter of recommendation from the employer. If self-employed, a letter from a professional colleague.

Selection Criteria:

A committee of LEADERSHIP JACKSON COUNTY graduates and community leaders oversees the selection process. Committee members account for the quality of answers to the questions on this application, the level of involvement and service to the community, and the recommendation letter. The class size is limited to 25 participants. The chamber will notify applicants by December 17, 2021.

<u>Attendance</u>

A participant who is absent from two sessions may be automatically dropped from the class. Notice of an impending absence must be given to the Jackson County Chamber of Commerce. Tuition is non-refundable.
